On behalf of the African Billiards and Snooker Confederation (ABSC) Board of Directors and in partnership with Snooker and Billiards South Africa (SABSA), the host federation, we are delighted to invite you to participate in the ABSC Championships.

### The events will take place from 20-30 July 2026

Play will begin on the 20<sup>th</sup> for the Seniors events. The 6 reds Event is scheduled to start on 22<sup>nd</sup> August. All the above is dependent on entries.

The championships consist of the following events.

- 1) The African Seniors Championships
- 2) The African 6 Reds Championships
- 3) The African Team Championships
- 4) The African Women's Championships (24-26<sup>TH</sup> JULY)
- 5) The African Singles Championships

The events all qualify for respective WPBSA events.

We look forward to Welcoming players, officials and delegates alike to Johannesburg at the Wanderers Snooker Club in Sandton, Illovo.

### Eligibility:

All the events are open to all amateur players in Africa with "African" Citizenship.

The Seniors players that are eligible must be 40 by end of June 2026.

All other players must be in Good standing with their relative associations in Africa.

If your country is not registered, kindly contact us for eligibility.

Any discrepancy will be dealt with by the board of the ABSC.

3) The entry fees have been set at \$70 per person for foreign Nationals from the rest of Africa. The South African Players will have to pay the equivalent set as per the USD currency as set by their own association. Local player's entries & terms will be decided by the SABSAs.

All South African Entries will come through Snooker & Billiards South Africa.

All Other entries will be to the email specified above.

Entry fees for all events are \$70 per event. No players will be allowed to play if payment is not made before the event.

## **The Venue & Hotel:**

The Protea Hotel by Marriot at the Wanderers is the Hotel that can be used by all International players. Players are welcome to check the best rates by using Booking.com and other portals. If we do get preferential rates soon enough we will send the link. The hotel only accepts credit card and currency in South African Rands.

Arrangements will be made to collect the players(International) from the airport as long as the flight information is correctly provided.

The Hotel is 50 m walking distance (in a safe environment) to the Wanderers Snooker Club at the Wanderers Club.

Transport will not be provided for any International players staying at any other hotel.

The International players must book and stay at the Protea Hotel at Wanderers to avoid any complications.

## **Tournament Format:**

Early round robin matches will be played over a minimum of best of five frames. Best of 3 for the Women's Championships. Knock outstages will commence from at least the last 32 stage, however, subject to total entries ABSC retains the right to extend the knockout stages and to shorten the groups if need be. Duration of matches for the knockout stages will be released at the time of issuing the draw and format of play.

## **DRESS CODE:**

The Dress code for both tournaments will be full formal dress code as approved by the WPBSA and World Snooker Tour, i.e., Waistcoat, bow tie, smart trousers, dress shirt and formal shoes with socks. Please note that clothes must be clean and worn correctly.
